- Name of school your child or children will attend in 2023 (if known)

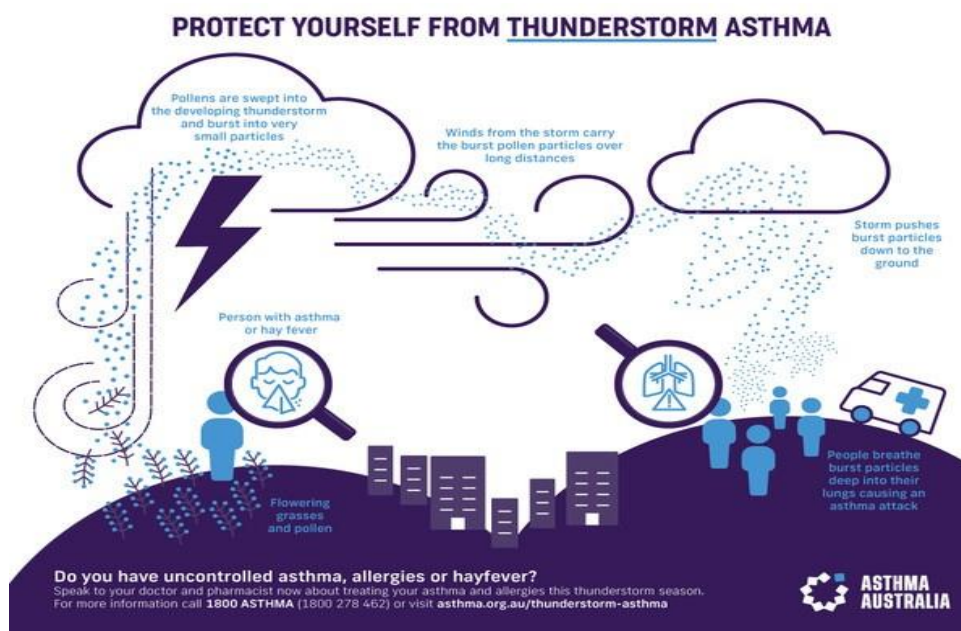
## News from Sickbay
